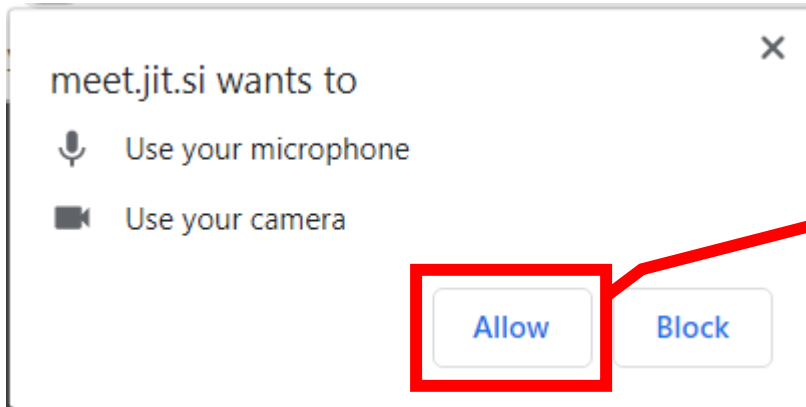
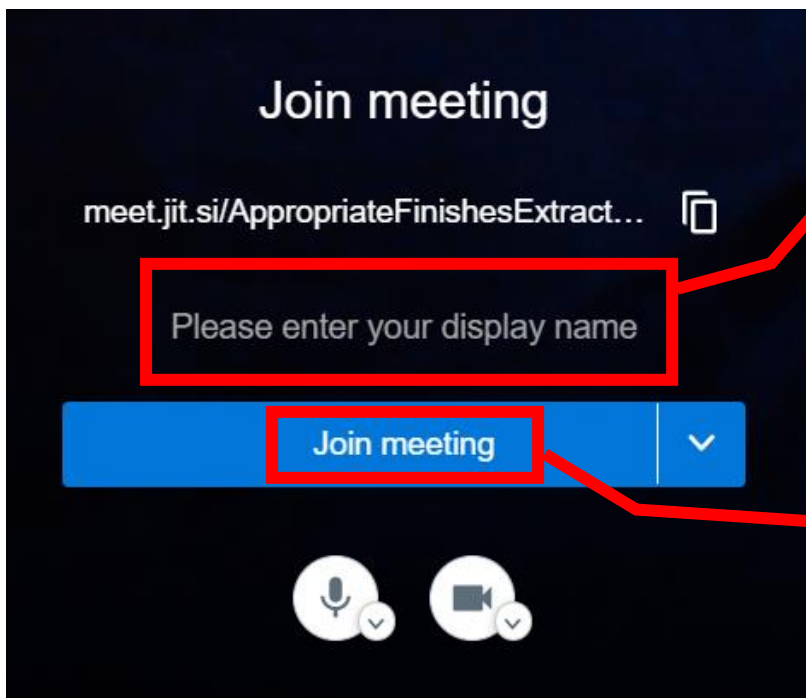


# jitsi.org Quick Start Guide

When you first open a link to a Jitsi meeting, you'll immediately see several on screen prompts. The appearance of these may vary depending your browser.



**Click  
"Allow"**

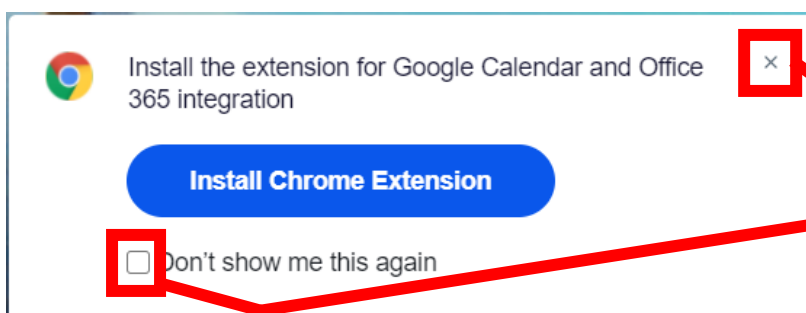


**Enter your name**

This will help other users know who's who.

Optionally, you could also include your club name in brackets.

**Click  
"Join Meeting"**




You don't need this. Just click on the "x" in the top right.

To prevent it asking again, you might want to tick the "don't show me this again" box first.

## Settings and Options

Your main actions for during the meeting are available from the bottom edge of the screen. Depending on the size of your screen, some options may be hidden behind a series of dots (which is in the bottom right corner). The various buttons hide themselves automatically, so you may need to move your mouse to make them reappear.

	<b>More actions</b> If you can't see the option you're looking for, it's probably hidden behind this button which can be found in the bottom right.
	<b>Raise / Lower you Hand</b> If you're struggling to make yourself heard and don't wish to be rude, click this to "raise your hand" and ask to speak.
	<b>Open / Close Chat</b> It may be useful to share some text such as URLs or other items. This is where that will happen. Everything that anyone types here can be seen by all the other attendees.
	<b>Mute / Unmute</b> This turns your microphone on and off. It may occasionally be useful to mute yourself if there are loud noises near you or you need to have a conversation with someone else in your location and don't want to interrupt the meeting.
	<b>Leave</b> This ends your connection to the meeting. If you click it by accident you can re-join using the same method as originally used.
	<b>Stop / Start Camera</b> This turns your camera on and off. If you only want to be heard and not seen, you may wish to use this. I found that if I toggled my camera off, it often wouldn't turn on again without re-joining the meeting.
	<b>Toggle tile view</b> Switches between seeing small pictures of everyone (tiled) and a big picture of the current speaker.
	<b>Settings</b> Only available from within "More actions". You can select which device to use as your camera, microphone or speakers. This might be useful if Jitsi doesn't seem to be working as expected.
